A good reader is always making connections when reading. This linking brings greater meaning to passages. Good readers link in three important ways:

TEXT TO SELF

Any link to your own life or others you know.



TEXT TO TEXT

Any link to another article, book, pamphlet, etc.



Directions:

Look through the newspaper for something that connects to your life, something that connects to something you've read and something that connects to the world. Look for connections in any part of the newspaper, including news, feature stories, editorials, cartoons, advertisements and comic strips.
