



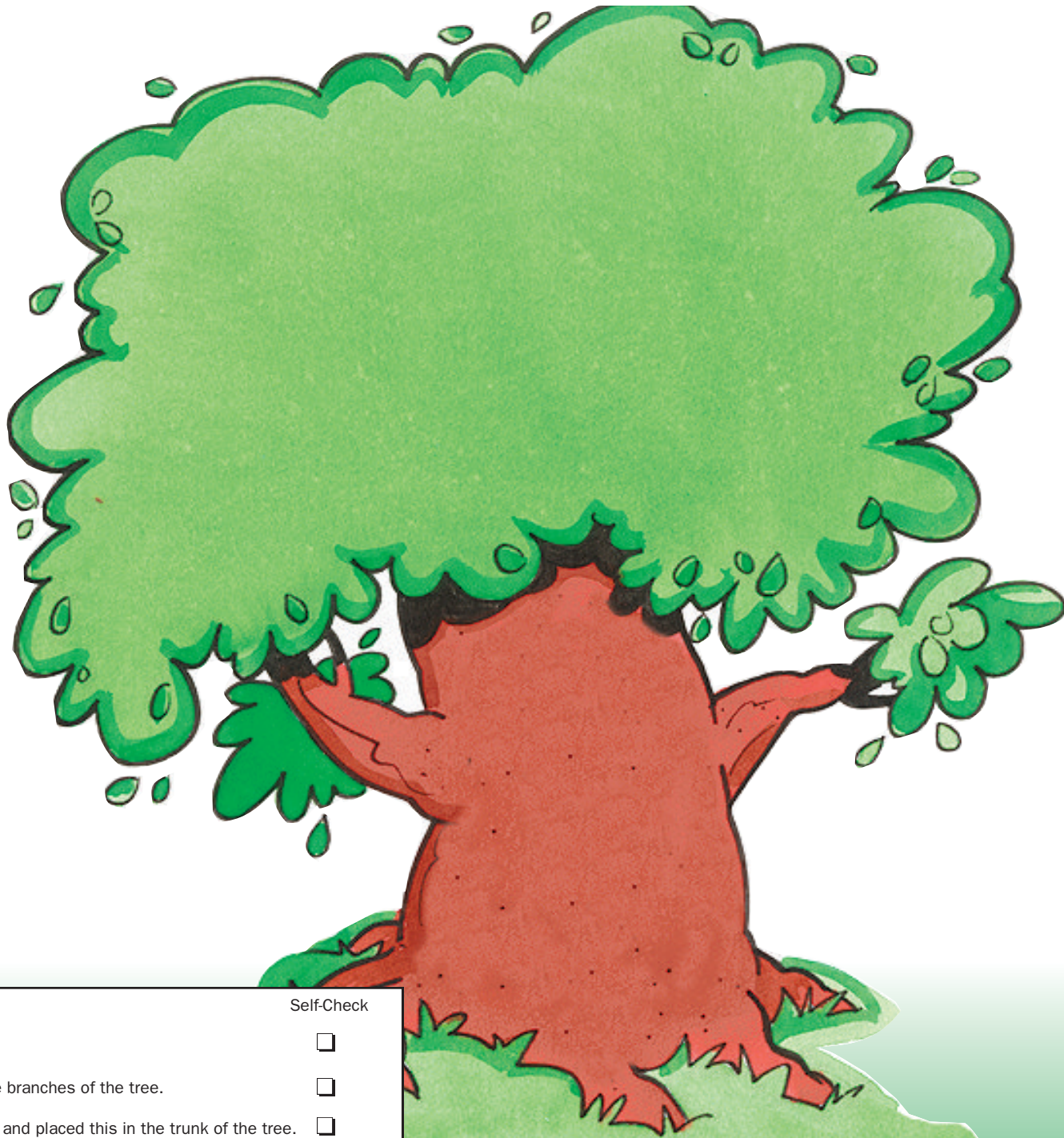
# Prediction Tree

Select a newspaper article that will probably be ongoing. Read and take notes on the article. Then use these notes to put information into a summary paragraph. Write this summary statement in the green portion of the prediction tree.

After summarizing the article, think about what you see happening next in this ongoing story. Make a prediction about the outcome of the story. Place this prediction in the trunk of the tree.

Look for two or three pieces of information in the article that show support for your prediction. Write this information in the base of the tree.

Continue to read the newspaper and look for future evidence that your prediction was correct or incorrect.
